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College Scholarship Fact Sheet

If you are an outstanding accounting student and leader, you are eligible to apply for the Kentucky Society of Certified Public Accountants Educational Foundation College Scholarships. The Foundation awards approximately 30 scholarships a year, ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,500. The scholarships recognize scholastic achievement and leadership qualities in students who plan to become CPAs.

To be eligible for the scholarships, applicants must:

- Be enrolled in a Kentucky college or university and be at least a sophomore at the time of application,
- Be a citizen of Kentucky or attending a Kentucky college or university,
- Have an overall grade point average of at least 2.75 and an accounting grade point average of 3.0,
- Have completed Principles of Accounting,
- Have completed or are enrolled in Intermediate Accounting,
- Indicate plans to sit for the CPA exam,
- Intend to stay and work/live in Kentucky upon graduation,
- If selected, recipient needs to agree to submit an application for student membership for the KyCPA before the scholarship is awarded.

To apply for the scholarships, applicants should submit the following:

- An official **2010 application form**
- College transcript(s) (Copies or printed transcript from school website acceptable.)
- A one-page essay stating career goals, reasons for choosing accounting, how you are financing your education and why you should receive this scholarship
- Two recommendations, one of which must be from an accounting faculty member
- **Important Note:** Please **DO NOT STAPLE** any of the forms! Also, if you are sending both scholarship and Becker Grant applications, please have a complete set of forms for each.

All applications must be postmarked January 29.

Winners will be notified by March 30. The scholarships will be presented at the Kentucky Society of CPAs Awards Banquet. **Do not staple your attachments to this document or to each other and do not print on the backside of any document.**
